Objectives of Mentoring

- To promote more interaction between teachers and students.
- To maintain proper academic and attendance records of students.
- To minimize drop-out rates among students.
- To differentiate slow learners and advanced learners.
- To maintain the discipline of students.
- To implement better understanding of the students potential.
- To record the achievements, both curricular and co-curricular.

Mode of Mentoring

- Mentees shall be assigned to the mentors right from the first year of the programme.
- Every mentor has 14 mentees.
- Mentors have to identify and study the minds of their students, make into their knowledge.
- The mentor shall meet the mentees regularly and record the outcome of the meeting in the hard copy. The details about each mentee will be recorded and periodically updated.
- Student mentors (faculty members) assess students continuously with their academic progress and all their activities are recorded and noted.
- Any discrepancies such as disciplinary issues, health issues, sense of insecurity, lack of attendance are discussed and noted in the register.
- Mentoring meeting is recorded every month during which mentors submit the register and the mentoring forms to the higher level monitoring and counseling committee.

Outcomes of Mentoring

- Provide impartial advice and encouragement to the students.
- Assist in problem solving and improve self confidence of the students.
- Improve students in internal assessment tests and semester examination.

General Observations


