Objectives of Mentoring

- To provide more interaction hours between teachers and students.
- To maintain proper academic and attendance records of students.
- To minimize drop-out rates among students.
- To identify slow learners and advanced learners.
- To check the discipline of students.
- To look into the health and physical well-being of students.
- To record the achievements, both curricular and co-curricular.
- To address stress related issues of students.

Mode of Mentoring

- Mentees shall be assigned to the mentors right from the first year of the program.
- Every mentors has 10 to 12 mentees.
- The mentees preferably be attached to the same mentor for the entire duration of the program.
- The mentor shall meet the mentees regularly and record the outcomes of the meeting in the hard copy. The details about each mentees will be recorded and periodically updated.
- The mentor shall identify the students performing exceptionally well in curricular or co-curricular activities and report to the head of the department for providing further motivation to advanced/gifted learners.
- The mentor shall also identify the students whose performance/attendance is below par. The mentor shall interact with the students and try to find out the cause of the problem or an indifferent behavior. If required the mentor will involve the parents, head of the department for reforming the student.
- The mentor shall also keep a track of the academic performance of mentees including continuous assessment and examination and help the mentee through counselling or by arranging remedial teaching, if necessary.

Outcomes of Mentoring

- Students are expecting to get the explanation in both Tamil and English in classroom
- Some students are good in communication and eager to learn more
- Most of the students have very good skill in cultural and sports
- A group of students asking to form web team to learn web designing
- Some students do not have any future plans. They have to be motivated to set goals.
- Students coming from poor family backgrounds do not have any source to pay the fees. So that we have instructed them to apply the scholarship without fail

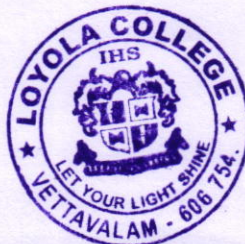
- Students need some extra computer training apart from the syllabus. So we are planning to give them an orientation program for our third year students.
