Accordingly, issues related to academics, cultural, sports and games, other extracurricular activities, spiritual thoughts, psychological strengths were discussed and analyzed. Based on the need, the mentees were advised for higher studies, motivated to improve their talents, guided for counselling, recommended for scholarships and free midday meals. To summarize in this batch 10 students were recommended for scholarships. The slow learners were identified and were asked to attend the remedial class programme. Out of 97 students enrolled, 90 students completed their degree programmes. The mentoring programme creates a lasting relationship between mentors and mentees.
