Objectives of Mentoring

- ✓ To provide more interaction hours between teachers and students.
- ✓ To maintain proper academic and attendance records of students.
- ✓ To minimize drop-out rates among students.
- ✓ To identify slow learners and advanced learners.
- ✓ To check the discipline of students.
- ✓ To look into the health and physical well-being of students.
- ✓ To record the achievements, both curricular and co-curricular.
- ✓ To address stress related issues of students.

Mode of Mentoring

- \checkmark Mentees shall be assigned to the mentors right from the first year of the program.
- ✓ Every mentors has 10 to 14 mentees.
- ✓ The mentees preferably be attached to the same mentor for the entire duration of the program.
- ✓ The mentor shall meet the mentees regularly and record the outcomes of the meeting in the hard copy. The details about each mentees will be recorded and periodically updated.
- ✓ The mentor shall identify the students performing exceptionally well in curricular or co-curricular activities and report to the head of the department for providing further motivation to advanced/gifted learners.
- ✓ The mentor shall also identify the students whose performance/attendance is below par. The mentor shall interact with the students and try to find out the cause of the problem or an indifferent behavior. If required the mentor will involve the parents, head of the department for reforming the student.
- The mentor shall also keep a track of the academic performance of mentees including continuous assessment and examination and help the mentee through counselling or by arranging remedial teaching, if necessary.

Outcomes of Mentoring

In this mentoring session we collected all basic information about the students.

- Staff asked the students to clear the previous semester arrears in the upcoming semester.
- ✓ Staff advised the students to prepare for a campus interview.
- ✓ Staff motivated the students to improve their communication skills.
- ✓ Staff informed the students to apply for the government scholarship.
- ✓ Also staff informed to all (SC/ST) and Minority students to apply for scholarships to those who did not receive it in the previous year.
- Staff appealed to all the first year students to register their names in any one of the Service units. Staff advised the students to join Typing Class.
- ✓ Staff encouraged the students to participate in the Inter Collegiate Competition.
- ✓ Staff motivated the students to read English Newspaper to improve their English Language. All the Staff informed the students to pay the semester fees.
- ✓ We motivated the slow learners to clear the arrear papers in the upcoming semester..
- ✓ Some students are struggling to pay semester fees so we recommended some students for management scholarships.
- Many students use mobile phones including hostel students and students were cautioned regarding spending more time in Mobile.
- ✓ Some Students feel that the elective subject is Difficult.
- ✓ Most of the students find it difficult to understand Maths.
- ✓ Few students expect to close the college at 1.30 PM.
- ✓ They expect some extra computer related certificate courses.
- ✓ They expect the type writing training programme.
- ✓ Students are very much interested in learning programming languages.
- ✓ In this Semester some students were given scholarships and some students are asked to attend remedial classes to pay more attention to academics.
