**Objectives of Mentoring**

- To provide more interaction hours between teachers and students.
- To maintain proper academic and attendance records of students.
- To minimize drop-out rates among students.
- To identify slow learners and advanced learners.
- To check the discipline of students.
- To look into the health and physical well-being of students.
- To record the achievements, both curricular and co-curricular.
- To address stress related issues of students.

**Mode of Mentoring**

- Mentees shall be assigned to the mentors right from the first year of the program.
- Every mentors has 18 to 19 mentees.
- The mentees preferably be attached to the same mentor for the entire duration of the program.
- The mentor shall meet the mentees regularly and record the outcomes of the meeting in the hard copy. The details about each mentees will be recorded and periodically updated.
- The mentor shall identify the students performing exceptionally well in curricular or co-curricular activities and report to the head of the department for providing further motivation to advanced/gifted learners.
- The mentor shall also identify the students whose performance/attendance is below par. The mentor shall interact with the students and try to find out the cause of the problem or an indifferent behavior. If required the mentor will involve the parents, head of the department for reforming the student.
- The mentor shall also keep a track of the academic performance of mentees including continuous assessment and examination and help the mentee through counselling or by arranging remedial teaching, if necessary.



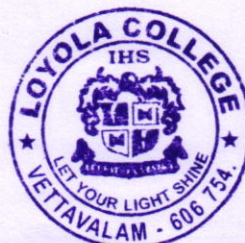
## Outcomes of Mentoring

- We informed the students to pay their semester fee.
- We advised the students to maintain discipline in the college.
- Also all the staff are advising the students to concentrate on their studies.
- If the girl Student has any physical problem we ask them to meet the dean of women's students for help and guidance.
- Some students are doing Part time Jobs.
- Students find it difficult to study mathematics.
- Most of the students come from poor backgrounds.
- Many students come from Tamil medium school.
- Staff advise the students to read English newspapers to develop their language skill.
- All the staff advised the students to join in the typing class.
- We asked all the SC/ST and minority students to apply for scholarships.
- Most of the students are first generation learners.
- Staff motivated the students to participate in sports and Cultural Events.
- Staff inform the students to register their names in any one of the service units.
- Some students expecting scholarship
- Some girl students are very eager to go for PG.
- Some students expect additional computer knowledge apart from the syllabus.
- Have very good opinions about the staff and department.
- Many Students go to part time jobs for their tuition fees.
- Some more students are expecting noon meals for those who are staying in their guardian home and they are poor.
- Girl's students expect female staff in our department.
- Few students have fear in the classroom. So they hesitate to come forward to talk.
- We informed the students who have not submitted their original certificates to submit within two or three days.
- Lot of students are very much interested in sports and culture.
- Some students need guidance for their PG Studies.
- Some students attended personal counseling in our college to come out from their personal problems.
- In this Semester some students were given scholarships and some students are asked to attend remedial classes to pay more attention to academics.
