BICS Basics in communicative Skill

Teaching communicative English is now a necessity for a good job for one's prosperous career in life. Fluency in English is a requirement in high ranking government positions. Realizing the need of the hour, the College is conducting a special course titled BICS (Basics in Communicative Skill).

The course was framed in such a way that it formed part of the curriculum. One hour per day is allotted for each class. BICS Classes are conducted for III, II & IUG students in the I, IV & VI hour respectively. The classes have helped the first generation students to speak English fluently. Fr. Secretary, Fr. Principal and Fr. Director of Campus Ministry handled maximum number of classes. A few staff members were specially recruited to handle these classes.

The course is based on well prepared syllabus. It is so planned that the first year students would be trained to improve their word power, second year students in speaking & reading and the third student's year would be trained in writing also.

Free Computer Coaching Classes

In Academic years 2016 – 2017 and 2017 – 2018, all I and II UG students are given computer training three hours per week. A team of Staff under the leadership of Prof. Selvam, Vice-Principal worked on the syllabus and pedagogy.
