### INAUGURATION OF LITRA- ASSOCIATION:

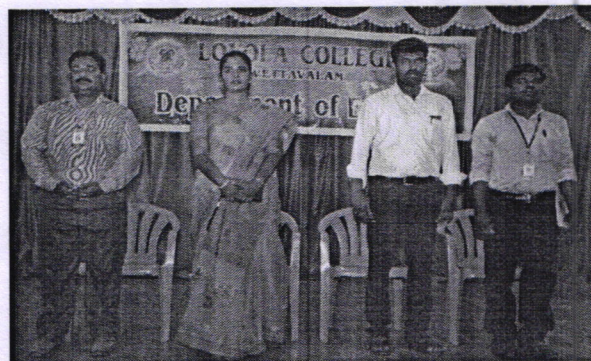

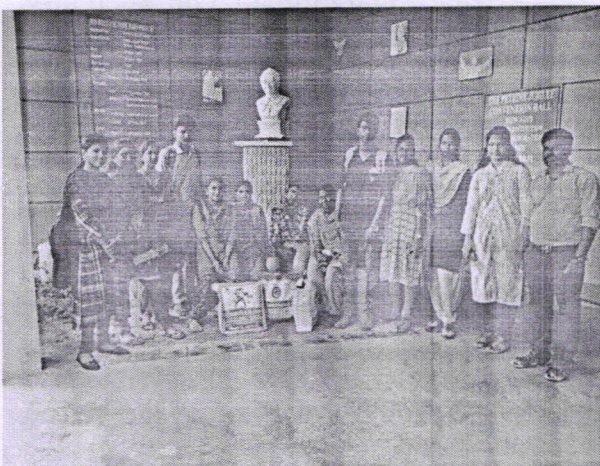

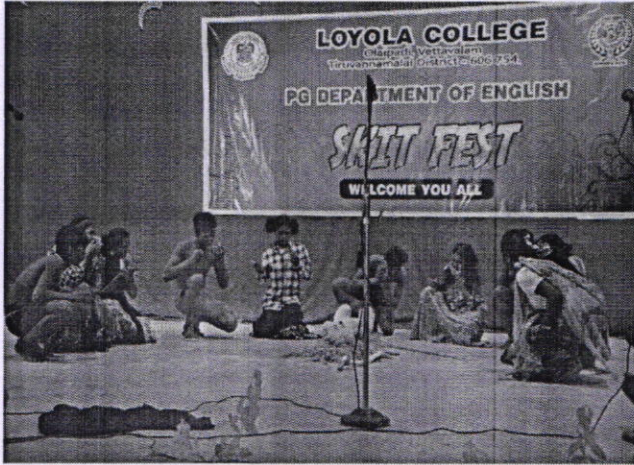


## INTER-COLLEGIATE COMPETITION: JOSELIT-19

## VETRIYALAR:

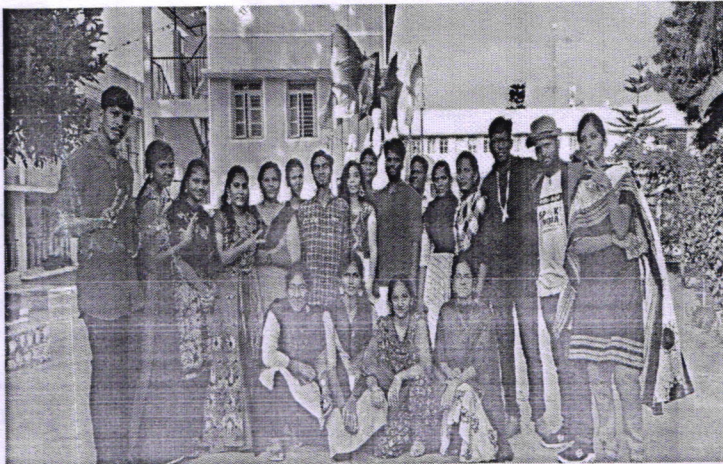

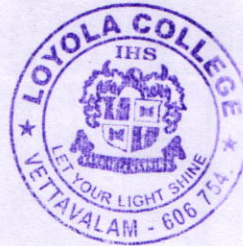
