Loyola College, Vettavalam is a branch of Loyola College, Chennai. It was established in the academic year 2009 - 2010 to educate and empower the rural poor, the first generation learners, the marginalized, the Dalits and the Women of this backward region. Loyola College is a pioneering initiative of the Jesuit Madurai Province to develop and strengthen the Jesuit Chennai Mission in the northern part of Tamil Nadu. The Government of Tamil Nadu through its G.O. No.164 of the Department of Higher Education (E1) dated 4 June 2009, granted approval for starting Loyola College of Arts and Science as a Self-Financing Co-Education College. The Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore granted Affiliation to Loyola College on 24 June 2009. The College abides by the rules and regulations of the Government of Tamil Nadu and the Thiruvalluvar University.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Any student who has successfully completed the Tamil Nadu Higher Secondary Course Certificate or any other course recognized by the University as equivalent to it, is eligible for admission to the Bachelor's Degree Courses.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Application for admission should be made in the prescribed form available in the College office. Students are requested to read the prospectus and the instructions given in the Application Form before filling the Application Form.

- * Tick in the Application Form the Course you want to study.
- * Affix your stamp size photo on the Application Form without fail.
- * Enclose all the required documents mentioned below:
 1. Attested xerox copies of Plus Two Mark Statement & TC.
 2. Attested xerox copy of the Community Certificate for SC / ST, BC, MBC / DNC students.
 3. Attested xerox copy of Certificate of proof for Differently Abled, Sports, NCC, Ex-Serviceman, etc.
 4. RC Christians should submit letter from their Parish Priest

SELECTION

Call Letter will be sent to those who are provisionally selected for admission in the College. The selected candidate will have to present himself / herself along with the parents for interview with the Principal on the date mentioned in the Call Letter without fail. The provisional selection is automatically cancelled if the candidate fails to be present for the interview on the scheduled date and time mentioned in the Call Letter. The Call Letter for the interview will be sent by post to the candidate. However, candidates could also contact the college office for admission details.

INTERVIEW

Candidates have to produce the following **ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES** at the time of interview for verification and submit them to the College Office without fail.

1. Higher Secondary Course Certificate (Plus Two Mark Statement).
2. Transfer Certificate, Conduct and Attendance Certificate.
3. Community Certificate (SC / ST, BC, MBC / DNC)
4. Certificate of Proof for Differently Abled, Sports, NCC, Ex-Serviceman, etc.

Candidates coming for the interview and admission, should pay the full fees at the time of Admission.

WITHDRAWAL

A student once enrolled for a course in the College is expected to complete the studies. He / She must not withdraw or discontinue from the College without informing the Principal in writing. Otherwise he / she will be liable to pay the fees for the period his / her name remains on the nominal rolls. A student who cancels admission after the start of the classes, the amount paid for the admission will not be refunded.

TO THE SPECIAL ATTENTION OF STUDENTS

- ❖ Ragging in any form is a serious offence and students indulging in Ragging will be summarily dismissed from the College.
- ❖ Smoking is strictly forbidden in the College premises.
- ❖ The use of alcohol and drugs is strictly prohibited. Any student found using drugs or other intoxicants will be immediately dismissed from the College.

Attendance is compulsory and the promotion of students will depend upon their regularity and discipline. Students will have opportunities to take additional Diploma / Certificate courses offered by the College relevant to their study.
